
CAMPUS TO CORPORATE WITH SAP


EXPOSURE TO HIGHER EDUCATION FOR GOVERNMENT HIGHER SECONDARY SCHOOL STUDENTS



INDUSTRIAL VISIT







FINE ARTS CLUB
